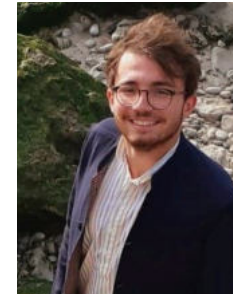


FRANCE

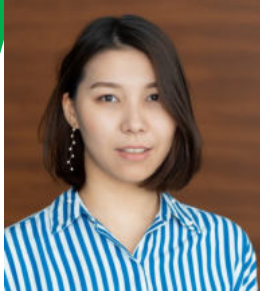

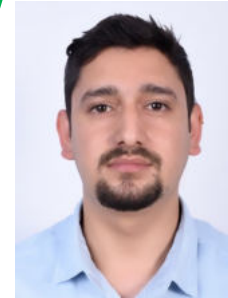

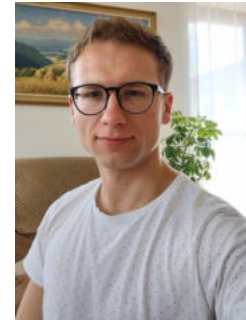


SLOVAKIA
