Invited Scholars and Guest Lecturers – Application Form

Scholarships can be awarded to leading academics and practitioners from any country in the world who will be selected by the Bioceb Consortium to contribute to the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree programme.

Scholars should have a good command of English and must demonstrate outstanding academic and/or professional experience and bring concrete added value to the Master Course and to the students through teaching of specific classes, leading seminars or workshops, monitoring and tutoring student research/project activities, participating in thesis reviews, preparing new teaching modules, etc.

A scholarship can be split into several stays. The scholar/guest lecturer can intervene during the Introduction Module in Reims, the Summer School in Tallinn and/or during the two years of the master at the Consortium universities (AgroParisTech, Aalto, ULiège, URCA, TalTech).

The amount of the scholar scholarship depends on the duration of the stay:

1 day=250 €

2 days=500 €

3 days=750 €

4 days=1000 €

5 to 7 days=1500 €

It represents a flat contribution to covers travel and installation costs as well as working fees, according to the duration of the stay.

Application form should be sent to the Bioceb secretariat: bioceb@agroparistech.fr, along with a CV and a Project Letter explaining the content and activities to be carried out during the visit.

COVID-19 note : If, due to the crisis, physical mobility is not possible, the use of e-teaching as alternative option can be authorised.
